Scholarship awards are granted to aid the recipient with the continuation of his or her education. This scholarship is geared towards graduating high school seniors.

To be considered for a scholarship, an applicant must:

- 1) Complete the application form provided below,
- 2) Be an active member of St. Luke's Church,
- 3) Have actively participated in Christian education classes (Sunday school, Bible study, or Youth Program), and
- 4) Provide two letters of recommendation from teachers, employers, etc. (but not the clergy of St. Luke's Church).

The involvement of the applicant in activities at St. Luke's will be weighed heavily in the selection process.

In addition to the above requirements, please provide a letter describing what you have learned from your association with St. Luke's and how you will apply this in your life. All paperwork must be submitted to the parish office by <u>July 5, 2019</u>. No late application will be considered. All information received will be the confidential property of the Scholarship Committee. The committee suggests that you obtain your recommendations immediately, since applications without recommendations will not be considered after the deadline.

Scholarships are awarded on a one-time basis. You may not apply again if you were previously awarded a scholarship. Scholarship awards tend to vary from year to year based on the overall funding available and the number of recipients.

Scholarship awards will be based on the following criteria:

- 1) St. Luke's Church involvement
- 2) Effort applied to the application, particularly the written essay and level of recommendations provided.
- 3) GPA level in high school
